Typical cost savings can be significant with E-Learning production in the order of 5-10 times lower than the classroom option.

Fire Safety

Fire is an ever-present hazard in all workplaces. If not managed correctly the consequences can be significant. Every year thousands of fires affect business premises, many with tragic outcomes. The financial costs associated with fire outbreaks can be very high, without robust business continuity planning, many organisations are unable to start up again.

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (RRFSO) aims to ensure the safety of employees by defining a responsible person as someone who is in control of the premises and places a number of duties upon them - including the need to make a suitable and sufficient risk assessment and to identify the general fire precautions required within a given business.

These duties should not be undertaken lightly and all business premises should ensure that their fire procedures are appropriate and well maintained.

Control of Contractors

Contractors can be especially useful when organisations need to undertake a task that perhaps requires a particular skill that they don't readily possess within their own workforce. The selection of the right contractor for a particular job is probably the most important element in ensuring that the risks to H&S of everybody involved in the activity and people in the vicinity are reduced as far as possible. Ideally, contractor selection should be made from a list of approved suppliers who have demonstrated that they are able to meet the client's H&S requirements.
